Founded just two years ago, Pia has developed this group wisely, assembling amazing talent combined with one of the main keys to success today - collaboration.**

Just look at the collaboration she has accomplished: Hair design is being developed by Carlos Salon in Peachtree City. Piano Crafters in Newnan will be contributing the use of a grand piano. *Zaphyra*'s wardrobe, obtained at David's Bridal.
